**Preliminary Examination** This is a contested hearing before the District Judge which must be set by law within twelve (12) days of the defendant's arraignment. The prosecutor calls witnesses to testify in an effort to convince the District Judge that a crime was, in fact, committed and there is probable cause to believe the defendant has committed the crime charged.

This procedure is relatively new in Michigan and is covered by Michigan Compiled Laws § 766.4.
