Colligative Properties of Electrolyte Solutions (See A Closer Look on p. 494) For colligative properties, — Electrolyte solutions vary from those of nonelectrolyte solutions — electrolytes dissociate into ions in solutions \Rightarrow increasing the total number of particles in solution \Rightarrow Because NaCl dissociates into Na^+ and Cl^- ions, the freezing-point depression for 0.1 mNaCl nearly double that for 0.1 msucrose
