The matching law may be viewed either as an empirical generalization, and thereby subject to disproof, or as part of a system of equations used to define the utility ("value") of a reinforcer. In the latter case it is tautologous, and not subject to disproof within the defining context. A failure to obtain matching will most often be a signal that the independent variables have not been properly scaled.

For the uninitiated, The Matching Law is a mathematical formula originating from the work of Herrnstein and others from the basic animal laboratory. The law seeks to describe how your responses are allocated across a variety of choices, each with a different schedule of reinforcement.

Using the Matching Law in Real Life - Behavioral Science ...

The matching law suggests that when different schedules of reinforcement are available at the same time for different behaviors, individuals will allocate their behavior according to the relative rates of reinforcement available for each option (Cooper, Heron, & Heward, 2007; Herrnstein, 1961; Reed & Kaplan, 2011).

Applying the Matching Law to Behavior Intervention ...

In operant conditioning, the matching law is a quantitative relationship that holds between the relative rates of response and the relative rates of reinforcement in concurrent schedules of reinforcement. For example, if two response alternatives A and B are offered to an organism, the ratio of response rates to A and B equals the ratio of reinforcements yielded by each response. This law applies fairly well when non-human subjects are exposed to concurrent variable interval schedules; its appli

The principle of the matching law applies really well to this because we make decisions daily based upon the density of reinforcement available to us. The matching law is sometimes confused with behavioral contrast, but the biggest difference is matching law requires concurrent schedules of reinforcement for two or more behaviors.

Herrnstein's (1961) contribution, known as the matching law, is significant in that it marked a shift from focusing on the presence or absence of a single target behavior (e.g., bar pressing) to a study of choice behavior

(e.g., pressing bar A versus pressing bar B).

The matching law can be outlined in the following equation: $R_a/R_b = r_a/r_b$ R_a/R_b are the rates of responses on the keys (a and b) by the subjects per (time), and r_a/r_b is the rate of reinforcement of keys (a and b) per (time).
